Let's go FOGO!

It's time to start placing your food scraps and other FOGO-friendly items into your lime green-lidded bin, along with your organic garden waste. Your lime green-lidded bin is now your FOGO bin. This bin will be collected weekly on your usual bin day.

FOGO will reduce our household waste going to landfill, and your FOGO bin contents will be turned into compost. This is game-changing for the environment, and we all get to do our part.

Kitchen caddy tips

- Collect your food scraps in the caddy and then place them (including the liner) into your FOGO bin.
- Only use the compostable liners provided by the City. Please do not use any other plastic bags.
- You can also line your caddy with newspaper, or nothing at all.
- Biodegradable or degradable bags must not be used for the FOGO bin. Use only certified compostable bags.

What goes in the recycling bin?

Items for recycling should be rinsed, clean and empty, with no lids.

- Glass bottles and jars (no lids)
- Paper (not shredded)
- Flattened cardboard
- Aluminium and steel cans
- Plastic bottles and containers (no lids)

What goes in the FOGO bin?

If it didn't live or grow, it's not FOGO! If in doubt, leave it out.

- Food scraps, bones, shells
- Tea bags, coffee grounds, used tissues
- Food-soiled paper towel and cardboard
- Compostable liners, shredded paper
- Dog poo, kitty litter
- Lawn clippings, weeds, prunings

What goes in the general waste bin?

Items that can't be composted or recycled. Items placed in this bin will get sent to landfill.

- Polystyrene, soft plastic
- Nappies, hygiene products
- Long-life milk cartons
- Disposable coffee cups
- Coffee pods
- Old clothing
