Public PC Service Terms and Conditions of Use

Before commencing this session please read and accept the Terms and Conditions listed below.

1. Use of Public PC Service Disclaimer

- The City of Bayswater will not take responsibility for the loss of data held on users' external drives (e.g. USB sticks) while connected to one of its Public PCs.
- The City of Bayswater will not accept responsibility for any losses or damages incurred by users while accessing content on the Internet via Library Services' Public PCs.
- It is the responsibility of parents or legal guardians to monitor their child's use of Library Services' Public PCs.

2. Inappropriate or illegal use of Public PCs.

Users must not attempt to:

- access pornographic, obscene, offensive or other material considered to be in bad taste
- access content that may incite hatred or violence
- breach software employed by any individual or organisation
- modify/gain access to software files stored on Library Services' PCs
- gain access to passwords or restricted data belonging to any individual or organisation
- transmit or request the transmission of objectionable and restricted material as defined by the *Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) Enforcement Act 1996*, or
- Contravene any product or site licensing agreement.

3. Those found using the Public PCs in an illegal, inappropriate or unethical manner will have their sessions terminated and may be ejected from the Library. Registered Library Members may also have their memberships temporarily suspended. Repeat offenders may also be permanently banned from using the Public PCs.

4. Copyright. Users must not use Library Services' PCs to breach the copyright of content available via the Internet unless permitted by the *Copyright Act 1968*.

Unauthorised copying or printing of a work in which copyright exists may infringe the copyright of that work.

5. No more than 2 people are permitted to sit at a Public Internet PC at a time.
6. Please note:
 - PCs will automatically become unavailable 5 minutes prior to a Library closing.
 - Library staff members may not be able to assist members with questions or issues that arise from their use of the Public PCs.
