Proposed Naming of Right-of-Way Bordered by Guildford Road, Milne Street, Neville Street and Roberts Street, Bayswater

The City of Bayswater hereby gives notice that Council at its Meeting held on 30 April 2024, endorsed the proposed name options 'Oblong Lane', 'Bartlett Lane' and 'Grace/Grace Hardie Lane' for the right-of-way (ROW) bordered by Guildford Road, Milne Street, Neville Street and Roberts Street, Bayswater, for public advertising.

It is proposed the ROW be named 'Oblong Lane' after Oblong turtles, a species of turtle is endemic to the southwestern part of Western Australia, 'Bartlett Lane' in commemoration of Rita Bartlett or 'Grace/Grace Hardie' in commemoration of Grace Hardie.
