LOCAL PLANNING POLICIES

The City of Bayswater hereby gives notice that Council, at its Ordinary Council Meeting held on 23 August 2022 resolved to adopt for public advertising the proposed modified Signage Policy; revoke the Mobile Food Vehicles Policy and the Sponsorship Signage on Reserves Policy; and adopt the Significant Tree Register for Private Land Policy and associated Guidelines.
