Call for Nominations – Community Representatives to the Inclusive Bayswater Advisory Group

The Inclusive Bayswater Advisory Group (IBAG) advises and assists the City of Bayswater to focus on promoting equality and equal opportunity for people with a disability, people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds, people who identify as LGBTQIA+, youth and older people accessing and utilising the City's services and programs.

We are seeking up to eight (8) community members to join the Group for a term until 18 October 2027, who meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Identify as LGBTQIA+; or be able to contribute expertise or advice on matters relating to LGBTQIA+ community members.
- Live with a disability or are a parent, carer, advocate of a person with a disability, or be able to contribute expertise or advice on disability.
- Bring valuable lived experience as either a young person (aged 15-25) or an older community member (aged 55 or over), offering insights into the opportunities and challenges that these age groups face in accessing services, facilities and community life.
- Identify as being from a culturally and linguistically diverse background or be able to contribute expertise or advice on matters relating to people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds.

Successful applicants will receive payment for attendance at Inclusive Bayswater Advisory Group meetings.
