PROPOSED ACTIVITIES IN THOROUGHFARES AND PUBLIC PLACES AND TRADING LOCAL LAW 2020

The City of Bayswater has resolved to repeal the *Activities on Thoroughfares and Trading in Thoroughfares and Public Places Local Law* and make a new *Activities in Thoroughfares and Public Places and Trading Local Law 2020* relating to the use of thoroughfares and public spaces.

Purpose: To make one local law regulating activities in thoroughfares and trading in thoroughfares and public places.

Effect: Some activities on thoroughfares and public places are prohibited and some activities are permitted only under permit or in compliance with conditions set out in this local law.
