

## CITY OF BAYSWATER FENCING AND FLOODLIGHTING LOCAL LAW 2016

In accordance with s3.12 (6) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, the City of Bayswater gives notice that on Wednesday 1 May 2019 the *City of Bayswater Fencing and Floodlighting Local Law 2016* was published in the WA Government Gazette.

This local law was made by Council at its Council Meeting date of 12 March 2019, however in the Government Gazette this date was incorrectly published as 26 March 2019.

The <u>purpose</u> of the Fencing and Floodlighting Local Law 2016 is to require sufficient fence and tennis court floodlighting, and provide the specifications for the construction and maintenance of fences and tennis court floodlighting throughout the district.

The <u>effect</u> of the *Fencing and Floodlighting Local Law 2016* is to establish the requirements for the construction and maintenance of fencing and tennis court floodlighting within the district.

In accordance with s3.14 (1) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, local laws come into effect on the 14th day after the day of publication in the WA Government Gazette.

This local law will therefore be effective from Wednesday 15 May 2019.
