Making a World of Difference Volunteer Celebration Grant Guideline

Who can apply?

Volunteer involving groups located in the City of Bayswater are invited to apply for the Making a *World of Difference Volunteer Celebration Grant*. These can include; sporting clubs, community groups, wildlife carers, performance and much more.

The purpose of this grant is to enable local community groups / organisations who engage volunteers in their delivery of services or activities to host a celebration event during 2019 National Volunteer Week. The grant will serve to acknowledge the contributions that local organisations make with support of volunteers toward progressing one or more of the Sustainable Development Global Goals



Eligibility

- Applicants must be either a local community group, club or organisation who engage volunteers in their delivery of services/ activities; are based in the City of Bayswater; and planning to host a celebration event for volunteers during National Volunteer Week (20–26th May 2019)
- 2. Applicants must identify how their group, club or organisation contributes toward one or more of the Sustainable Development Global Goals with the support of their volunteers.
- 3. Applications must be signed by the President from the community group, club or organisation.
- 4. Successful applicants must provide the City of Bayswater with an electronic photo and brief summary of how volunteers were celebrated at the event during National Volunteer Week no later than Friday, 7 June 2019 to receive payment. (Summary to be no more than 100 words and include a minimum of 1 photo (Hi resolution jpeg), which may be used for promotional purposes).

The City of Bayswater's decision of successful grant recipients is final and no disputes will be entered into. All successful applications will need to meet each of the four criteria listed above.

Grant

The City of Bayswater has five (5) 'Making a World of Difference Volunteer Celebration Grants' available to local community groups/organisations who engage volunteers in their delivery of services or activities to the value of \$500 (plus GST)

Successful applicants will receive payment on receipt of invoice, photo and brief summary.

What are the Sustainable Development Global Goals?

There are 17 Sustainable **Development Goals** otherwise known as the Global Goals, which are a universal call to action to end poverty, protect the planet and ensure that all people enjoy peace and prosperity.

TARGET 12.5 SUBSTANTIALLY REDUCE WASTE GENERATION

What

Reduce the amount of disposable coffee cups waste by encouraging people in the community to use reusable cups at sporting events

Why

1 billion disposable cups are handed out in WA annually, 90% of cups not recyclable. Opportunity to reduce waste at the local level and make Bayswater better!

Where

Community events held at the sporting club

How

Educate community to bring their own cups to local events

Electronic receipt of photo and brief summary on how the group celebrated the National Volunteer Week needs to be received by Friday, 7 June 2019
