# Bin collection tips

Place two bins out for collection each week:

## Public holidays

Due to public holidays, bins usually collected between 25 and 27 December, 1 and 3 January and on 18 April will be collected the following day.

## Bin collection missed?

If your bin was missed in the collection, call **9272 0605** to report the missed bin within 48 hours.

## Remember

- Do not park vehicles in front of the bins.
- Place bins next to the kerb by 6am.
- Keep the weight of the bin under 70kg.
- Avoid overfilling to ensure lid can close.
- Place front of the bin facing the road.

## Have you left enough space?

At least 1m from cars, street signs or power poles



Place bins at least 50cm apart



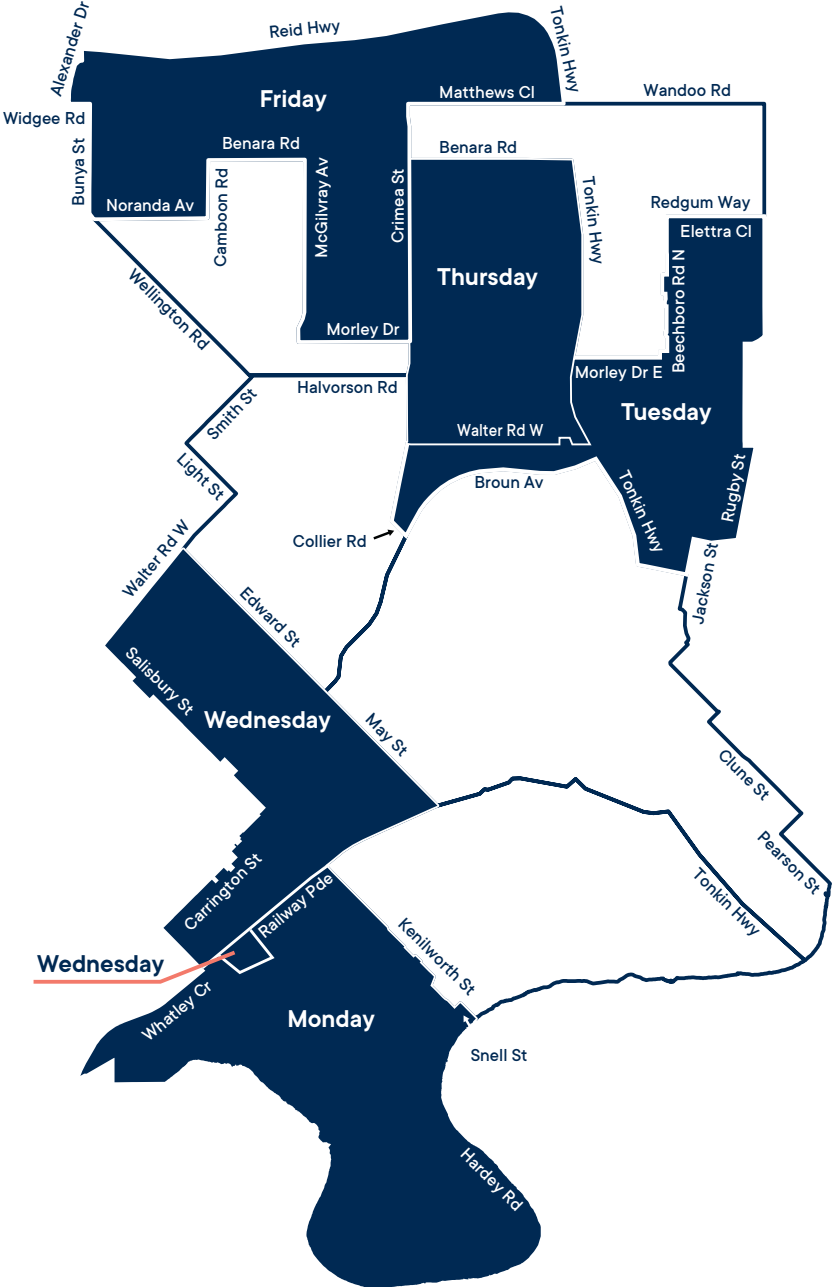
At least 1m from trees and not under a tree canopy

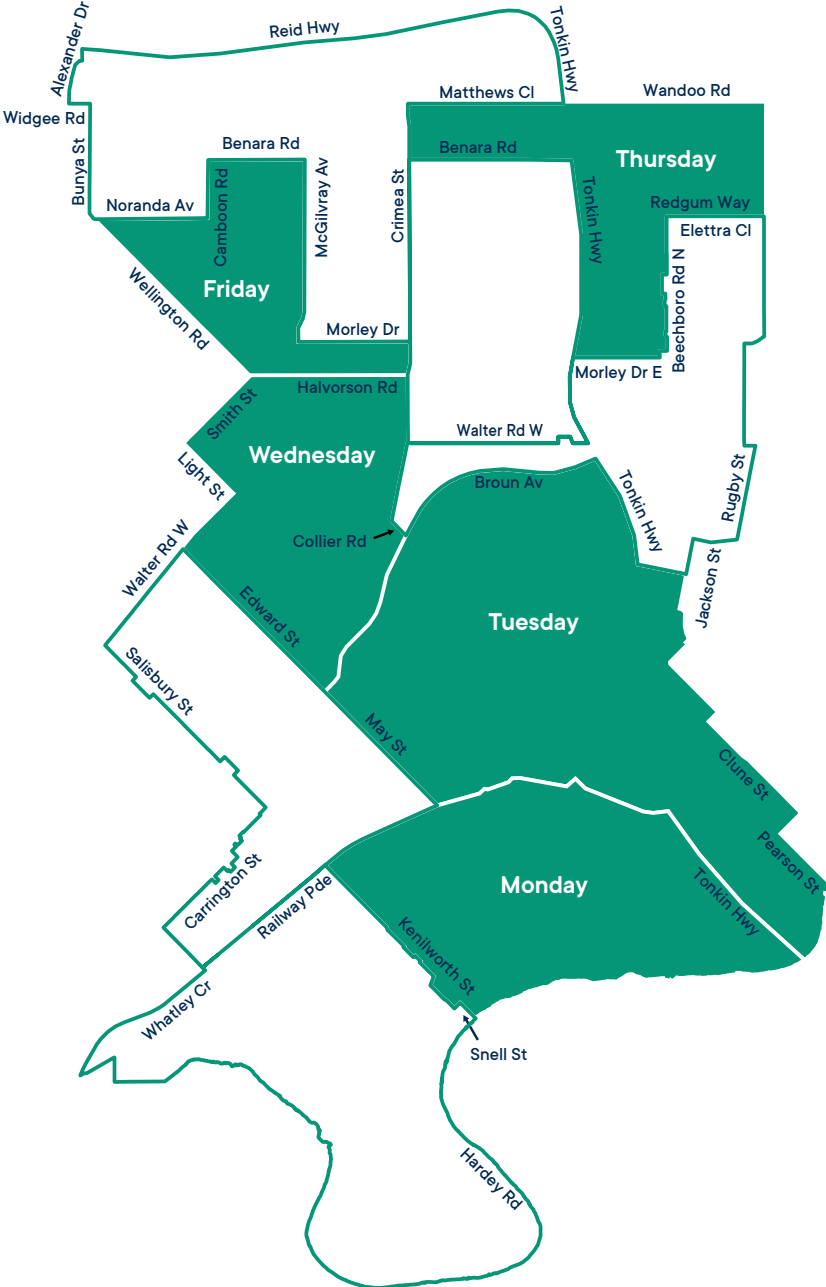

# Using your FOGO kitchen caddy

- 

1 Line the caddy with your compostable liner. You can use newspaper instead when your bags run out (newspaper is compostable too).
- 

2 Place all your food scraps and other compostable material like coffee grounds and paper towels in the caddy.
- 

3 After 2 - 3 days, or when the liner is full, put it in your FOGO bin. Food scraps can also be placed loosely in the bin.

## Compostable liners

The City will provide two rolls of liners per waste year, per household free of charge. The waste year runs from April 1 to March 31. You can collect liners from one of the City's libraries or the Civic Centre at 61 Broun Avenue, Morley. Please bring identification that shows your address.

You can also purchase compostable liners from supermarkets and hardware stores. Only purchase and use caddy liners that display the seedling symbol on the packaging. This means they are compostable under Australian Standards.



Only use caddy liners that are certified compostable under Australian Standards.

## Food Organics Garden Organics - weekly

**If it didn't live or grow, it's not FOGO.**

**Place these items in your  
green lid FOGO bin:**

- ✓ Certified compostable caddy liners
- ✓ Food scraps, including meat, seafood, bones and shells
- ✓ Bread and dairy
- ✓ Tea bags and coffee grounds
- ✓ Shredded paper and tissues
- ✓ Prunings (up to 30cm)
- ✓ Lawn clippings
- ✓ Leaves
- ✓ Weeds

**Do not place these items in your  
green lid FOGO bin:**

- ✗ No aerosol cans or gas bottles
- ✗ No batteries or electronic waste
- ✗ No clothes or textiles
- ✗ No glass
- ✗ No metal
- ✗ No nappies
- ✗ No plastic bags
- ✗ No coffee pods
- ✗ No single use coffee cups
- ✗ No kitty litter



Collect more liners from a City of Bayswater library  
or the City of Bayswater Civic Centre.



**The contents of your recycling bin will be recycled into new material.**

## Recycling - fortnightly

**Please don't bag your recyclables. Place all items loose into the bin. Please remove lids and rinse all jars, cans, bottles and containers.**

**Place these items in your yellow lid recycling bin:**

- ✓ Glass bottles and jars - rinsed and lids removed
- ✓ Paper - not shredded (including newspaper and magazines)
- ✓ Cardboard - flattened
- ✓ Plastic bottles and containers - clean, empty and no lids
- ✓ Steel and aluminium cans - clean and empty

**Do not place these items in your yellow lid recycling bin:**

- ✗ No aerosol cans or gas bottles
- ✗ No batteries or electronic waste
- ✗ No clothes or textiles
- ✗ No materials in plastic bags
- ✗ No nappies, hygiene or sanitary products
- ✗ No soft plastics (e.g. plastic bags and wrappers)
- ✗ No ropes, cables or hose
- ✗ No UHT (long-life/silver lined) cartons
- ✗ No single use coffee cups

## General waste - fortnightly

**Your red lid general waste bin is for items that can't be composted or recycled.**

**Place these items in your red lid general waste bin:**

- ✓ General rubbish items
- ✓ Hygiene and sanitary products
- ✓ Nappies
- ✓ Polystyrene and soft plastic
- ✓ Coffee pods
- ✓ UHT (long-life/silver lined) cartons
- ✓ Clothing and textiles
- ✓ Meat trays
- ✓ Kitty litter

**Do not place these items in your red lid general waste bin:**

- ✗ No food organics or garden organics
- ✗ No clean recyclables
- ✗ No hazardous waste like aerosols, light globes or batteries
- ✗ No hot ashes or liquids
- ✗ No sand or soil
- ✗ No construction, demolition or building materials

# Bulk waste

Request up to three bulk bins or tip passes each waste year (1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025). To book a bin online or view available delivery dates, visit [bayswater.wa.gov.au/bulkbin](https://bayswater.wa.gov.au/bulkbin) or call Cleanaway on **9449 3338**. Book in advance if a specific delivery date is required. Not enough space on your verge? Contact the City to make alternative arrangements.

## Blue bulk bin



### General waste

- ✓ Bulky household items, dismantled furniture, timber and toys.

### Do not place these items in your blue bulk bin:

- ✗ No building materials
- ✗ No asbestos
- ✗ No mattresses or white goods
- ✗ No hazardous items like chemicals, batteries or paint
- ✗ No liquids
- ✗ No car parts including tyres
- ✗ No electronic waste
- ✗ No glass
- ✗ No green waste



### All bulk bins

Only fill to the top of your bin.

Carefully read the list of allowable contents as charges may apply for disposal of items not permitted.

Do not shift the bin from the place where it is delivered and keep the area around it clear.

## Green bulk bin



### Green waste

- ✓ Grass clippings, leaves and branches (up to 1.5m long and 15cm wide).

### Do not place these items in your green bulk bin:

- ✗ No household items like furniture, mattresses or white goods
- ✗ No sand or lawn sods
- ✗ No treated timber or sleepers
- ✗ No plastic or recyclables
- ✗ No building materials or asbestos
- ✗ No liquids
- ✗ No pet waste

### Mattresses and white goods

Request up to two mattress or white goods home collections per year.

### Accepted waste and fees:

- General waste: Fee payable.
- Asbestos: Fee payable. Must be wrapped in plastic sheeting and taped.

- Television and computer recycling: No charge. Whole products only accepted. Cathode Ray Tubes (CRTs) out of casing or cracked/broken are not accepted.
- Household hazardous waste (HHW) only: No charge for household quantities (no more than 20kg / 20L per material type). Mixed waste (HHW and/or recyclables with general waste) will incur a fee.

## Household hazardous waste

These items can be dropped off for free at Red Hill Waste Management Facility. Limit of 20kg or 20L per material type per day.

Examples include:



Gas cylinders and aerosols



Batteries



Flammables



Corrosives



Pesticides and herbicides



Poisons



Fire extinguishers (non-halon)



Paint and solvents



Fluorescent lights and light globes

Recycle them at a registered B-cycle drop off point. B-cycle is Australia's official battery recycling scheme.
