

Bulk bins and tip passes

Request up to three bulk bins or tip passes each waste year (1 April 2024 – 31 March 2025). Book a bin online at bayswater.wa.gov.au/bulkbin or call Cleanaway on **9449 3338**. Not enough space on your verge? Contact the City to make alternative arrangements.

Blue bulk bin - general waste

- ✓ Bulky household items, dismantled furniture, timber and toys.

Do not place these items in your blue bulk bin:

- ✗ No building material
- ✗ No asbestos
- ✗ No mattresses or white goods
- ✗ No hazardous items like chemicals, batteries, paint or liquids
- ✗ No glass
- ✗ No car parts including tyres
- ✗ No electronic waste
- ✗ No green waste

Green bulk bin - green waste

- ✓ Grass clippings, leaves and branches (up to 1.5m long and 15cm wide).

Do not place these items in your green bulk bin:

- ✗ No household items like furniture, mattresses or white goods
- ✗ No sand or lawn sods
- ✗ No treated timber or sleepers
- ✗ No plastic or recyclables
- ✗ No building material or asbestos
- ✗ No liquids
- ✗ No pet waste

Tip passes

If you would rather use the tip, visit the City of Bayswater Civic Centre or a City library to collect your passes. Simply present a current identification document that includes your property address to collect your pass.

The contents of your FOGO bin will be **composted**.



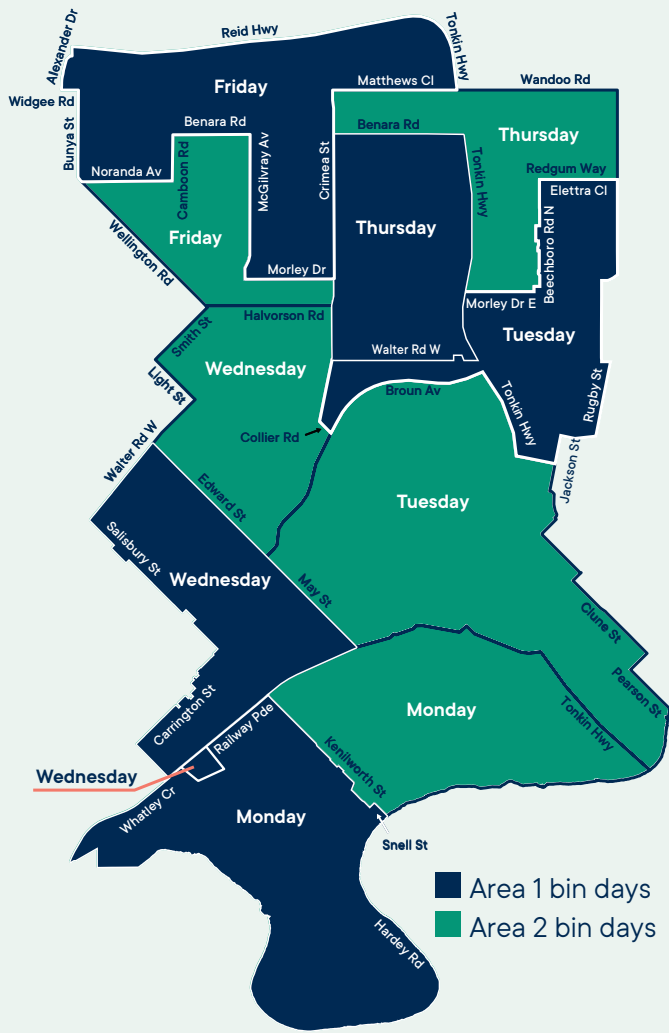
The contents of your recycling bin will be recycled into **new material**.



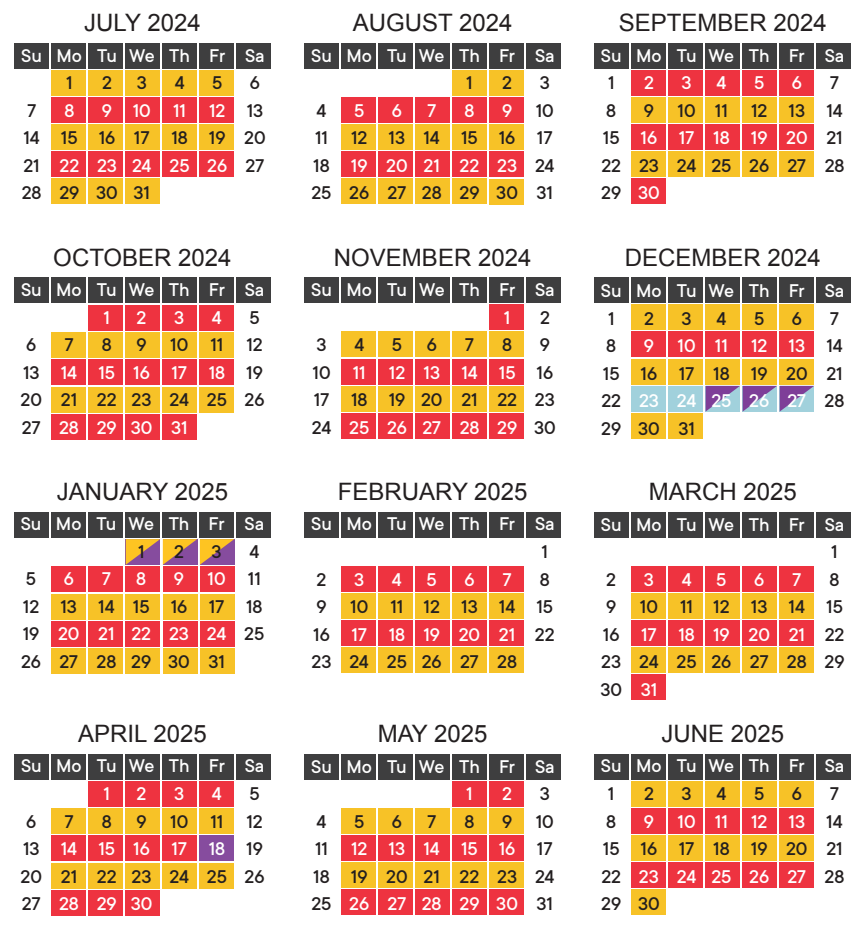
The contents of your general waste bin will go to **landfill**.



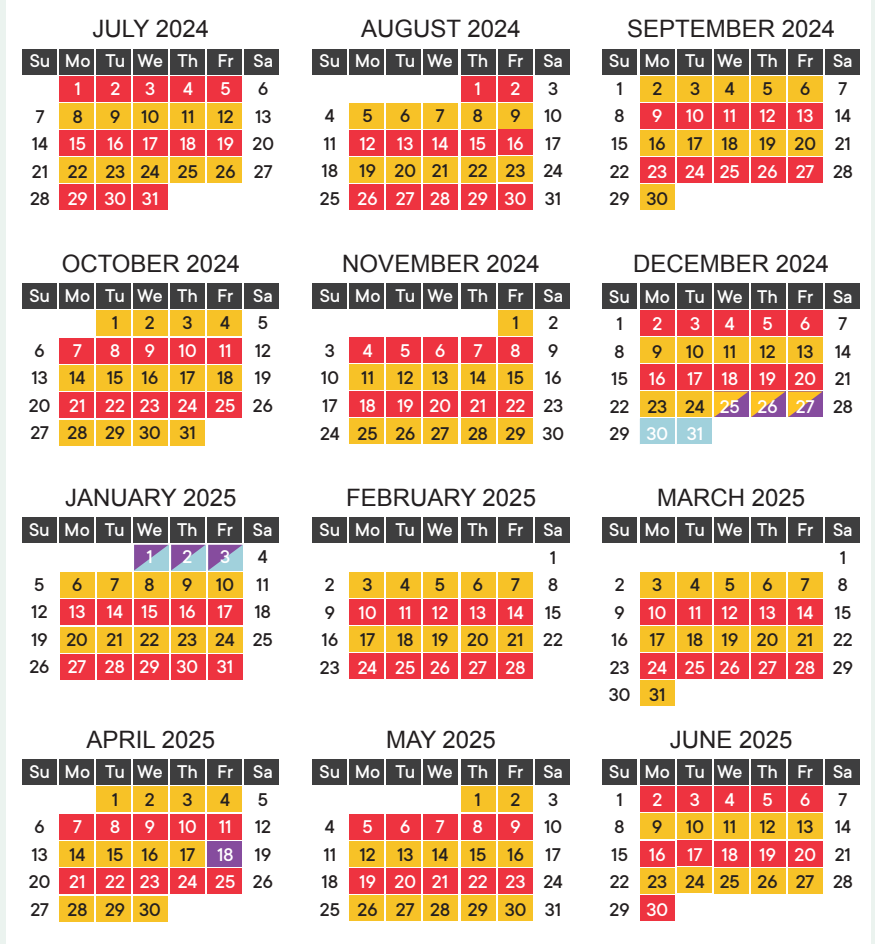

Area 1 bin days

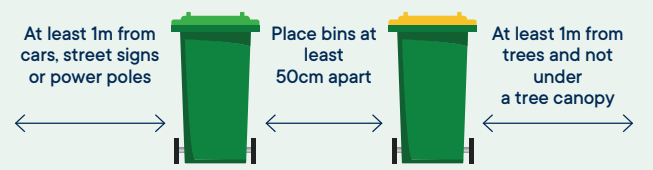


Area 2 bin days

Have you left enough space?



To help us collect your bins quickly and easily, please leave space around bins.

Remember:

- Do not park vehicles in front of bins.
- Place bins next to kerb by 6am and remove from verge within a reasonable time after collection.
- Keep the weight of the bin under 70kg.
- Avoid overfilling to ensure lid can close.
- Place front of the bin facing the road.
