PROPOSED DOGS AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2025

The City of Bayswater Council previously resolved to amend the current *Dogs Local Law* 2016, and at the Ordinary Council Meeting on 29 April 2025 resolved to advertise the City's proposed *Dogs Amendment Local Law* 2025 for the purposes of seeking public comment.

The <u>purpose</u> of the *Dogs Amendment Local Law 2025* is to amend the City of Bayswater's *Dogs Local Law 2016*.

The <u>effect</u> of the <u>Dogs Amendment Local Law 2025</u> is to remove Part Two (relating to the impounding of dogs); include a new modified penalty for "Failing to provide effective means to contain dog"; include a new clause 2.3 "Direction to provide a suitable enclosure"; increase the value of modified penalties for offences under the local law and update legislation in accordance with the <u>Dog Act 1976</u>.
