CITY OF BAYSWATER

KEEPING AND CONTROL OF CATS AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2023

In accordance with s3.12(6) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, the City of Bayswater gives notice that on 1 September 2023 the City of Bayswater *Keeping and Control of Cats Local Law 2023* was published in the WA Government Gazette (Gazette Number 115 – General Edition).

This local law was made by Council at its Ordinary Council Meeting of 22 August 2023.

The <u>purpose</u> of the local law is to amend the City of Bayswater's *Keeping and Control of Cats Local Law 2022.*

The <u>effect</u> of the local law is to remove clause 2.2. "Cats in Other Places", remove item 2 of Schedule 2 (offence penalty), and include an additional area in Schedule 3, "Cat Prohibited Areas", being Bayswater Industrial Area as bordered by Collier Road, Beechboro Road South, the Bayswater Brook, Colwyn Road, Pearson Street, the boundary with Town of Bassendean and Tonkin Highway

In accordance with s3.14(1) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, local laws come into effect on the 14th day after the day of publication in the WA Government Gazette.

This local law will therefore be effective from 15 September 2023.
