## LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROPERTY AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2025

In accordance with s3.12(6) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, the City of Bayswater gives notice that on 17 April 2025 the City of Bayswater *Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2025* was published in the WA Government Gazette (Gazette Number 44 – General Edition).

This amendment local law was made by Council at its Ordinary Council Meeting of 25 March 2025.

The <u>purpose</u> of the Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2025 is to amend the City of Bayswater's Local Government Property Local Law 2016.

The <u>effect</u> of the *Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2025* is to include a new clause 5.9 – "Unclaimed Items on Local Government Property" and to increase the modified penalties within the proposed local law within Schedule 1.

In accordance with s3.14(1) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, local laws come into effect on the 14<sup>th</sup> day after the day of publication in the WA Government Gazette.

This local law will therefore be effective from 1 May 2025.
