



## PUBLIC NOTICE CITY OF BAYSWATER REVIEW OF LOCAL LAWS

In accordance with section 3.16 of the *Local Government Act 1995* the City of Bayswater is required to periodically review all of its local laws at least once every eight years.

The following local laws are currently being reviewed by the City of Bayswater:

- Local Government Property Local Law 2016
- Parking and Parking facilities Local Law 2016
- Dogs Local Law 2016

Submissions may be lodged to the City about the content of the local laws, and these will be presented to Council who will then consider whether to amend, repeal or retain these local laws.
