Membership Joining Conditions

The City of Bayswater Library Service offers 3 types of membership. Each type has different joining conditions.

- **Standard Memberships** allow members to loan physical items, eBooks, eMagazines etc; have access a suite of online services; and free use of our Public PCs. All PCs provide access to the Internet.
 - Those applying for this membership must provide formal ID, proof of current residential address and the name and telephone number of a contact person.
- eMemberships are for those who only want access to our Public PCs and downloadable eBooks, eMagazines and eAudio. This membership only requires the provision of formal identification.
 - The types of documents that will be accepted as identification and proof of address are as follows:
 - Bank Statement
 - Social Security/Pension/Centrelink/Health Care Card
 - Student card
 - Motor Vehicle Registration Notice
 - Rates notice, rental/lease agreement or mortgage documentation
 - Telephone or Utilities Account (i.e. electricity, water and gas)
 - Passport (for identification only)
 - > WA Driver's Licence or Learner's Permit
 - Those joining as Standard or eMembers are required to sign a Register that indicates that they have read and accept the conditions of use associated with their membership.
 - Applicant's that are less than 18 years of age must have their parents/legal guardians join and sign the Membership Register on their behalf.
 - Applicants below the age of 18 will be allowed to join without their parent/legal guardian's signature if their parent/guardian resides a significant distance from them; or they are estranged from their parent/guardian.

 Institutional Memberships. Representatives of organisations applying for institutional memberships must provide a letter of application addressed to the Manager Library Services on their organisation's official letter stationery. The letter must clearly indicate who will be financially responsible for items lost, damaged or stolen while on loan to the organisation, and be signed by the officer with that financial.
