PROPOSED KEEPING AND CONTROL OF CATS AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2022

The City of Bayswater has resolved to amend the current *Keeping and Control of Cats Local Law 2022* as requested by the Joint Standing Committee on Delegated Legislation.

The purpose of the local law is to amend the City of Bayswater's *Keeping and Control* of Cats Local Law 2022.

The effect of the local law is to remove clause 2.2. "Cats in Other Places", remove item 2 of Schedule 2 (offence penalty), and include an additional area in Schedule 3, "Cat Prohibited Areas", being Bayswater Industrial Area as bordered by Collier Road, Beechboro Road South, the Bayswater Brook, Colwyn Road, Pearson Street, the boundary with Town of Bassendean and Tonkin Highway.
