LOCAL PLANNING POLICY - DRAFT DEVELOPMENT APPROVAL EXEMPTIONS POLICY

The City of Bayswater hereby gives notice that Council at its Ordinary meeting held 24 February 2026 resolved to adopt for public advertising the draft Development Approval Exemptions Policy.

The policy outlines low-risk development proposals which are exempt from requiring development (planning) approval from the City. The draft policy aims to improve customer experience through time and cost savings to business owners and landowners by reducing the need for development approval for some developments proposals within the City.
