City of Bayswater Community Grants Program

The City of Bayswater Community Grants Program can enable you or your organisation to achieve more.

We invite you to partner with us to help deliver better outcomes for our community.

The City offers a number of different grants that your organisation, project or event may be eligible for:



Better Bayswater Grant

The Better Bayswater Grant is a new funding stream for the City, targeted at community activities that help to deliver outcomes specified in the City of Bayswater Strategic Community Plan.

Eligibility requires matching funding from the applicant or other sources, with the City meeting a maximum of 50% of the cost of the successful project or activity, including in-kind support up to the value of \$5,000.

Applications for the *Better Bayswater Grant* open twice per year.

Further eligibility requirements are outlined in the *Better Bayswater Grant Information Form*.

Community Capital Requests

The City offers grant funding to support established community not-for-profit organisations based and operating within the City who are seeking a capital funding contribution in order to improve facilities and infrastructure.

Priority is focussed towards projects valued between \$5,000 and \$20,000 that are supported with a proven financial contribution from the applicant, and provide tangible benefits to the local community. All applications must include a minimum of two written quotations in order to support project costs.

Applications are considered on a case by case basis and are invited annually.

Community Events Grant

The City offers grant funding through its Community Grants Program to support established community not-for-profit organisations in delivering vibrant, accessible and inclusive community events across the City of Bayswater.

Applications for Community Events Grants open twice per year.

Further eligibility requirements are outlined in the *Community Events Grant Application Form*.

The City of Bayswater welcomes requests for donations from eligible individuals or community groups seeking financial assistance for an initiative that meets the criteria of either of these categories:



Individual Donations

The City of Bayswater will consider requests from individuals for financial assistance toward travelling costs, when participating in state or national representative events intrastate, interstate or overseas.

Details of the event and the role of participant's attendance are to be included in the request.

Preference will be given to supporting travel expenses towards events which promote personal and leadership development, or community involvement.

Further eligibility requirements are outlined in the *Individual Donation Application Form*.

Group Donations

The group donation program aims to support cultural and community projects, events and initiatives occurring within the City, which align with the City of Bayswater Strategic Community Plan. This can include provision of one-off donations to organisations or community groups based in, or providing events or services to, the City of Bayswater local government area.

This program seeks to encourage new services and resources, increase community participation and create a vibrant cultural and community life in the City of Bayswater.

Further eligibility requirements are outlined in the *Group Donation Application Form*.



Applications can be made throughout the year, please be aware that the amount of donations requested each year may outweigh the available budget, therefore, not all donation requests may be able to be funded.
