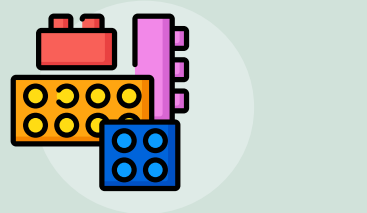
Learning English through Storytime
