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1. INTRODUCTION

Public notice is required for proposed disposition of property and land, by way of lease, license or sale pursuant to Section s.3.58 and 3.59 of the *Local Government Act 1995*.

Pursuant to this, the City of Bayswater hereby gives public notice of consideration by the City of Bayswater to enter into a license with Hawaiian Pty Ltd, for the portion of the land at Lot 100, 75 McGilvray Avenue, Noranda known as the carpark at Hawaiian Noranda (Shopping Complex) and Noranda Sporting Complex.

Section 3.58 of the Local Government Act 1995:

- "(3) A local government can dispose of property other than under subsection (2) if, before agreeing to dispose of the property—
 - (a) it gives local public notice of the proposed disposition
 - (i) describing the property concerned; and
 - (ii) giving details of the proposed disposition; and
 - (iii) inviting submissions to be made to the local government before a date to be specified in the notice, being a date not less than 2 weeks after the notice is first given;

In summary, the details of the disposition must be disclosed, including the description of the property in question, the consideration (price) and the market value.

The purpose of the license is to facilitate car parking and access through the area for employees, agents, contractors, customers, tenants and visitors.

Public comments are invited on the proposed disposition and the submissions will be considered at the first available meeting of Council after the closing date, should submissions be made.

2. SITE DESCRIPTION

2.1 Location

The subject site is situated at Lot 100, 75 McGilvray Avenue, Noranda and owned in freehold by the City of Bayswater.

The portion of land is level, and of an elongated rectangular shape along the northern boundary of the Lot with an area of approximately 2,740 sqm comprising a carpark of 105 bays, 2 motor cycle bays, verge and a trolley return.

3. BACKGROUND

The portion of land comprising carpark at Lot 100, 75 McGilvray Noranda supports the function of the Noranda Shopping Centre and the Noranda Sporting Complex with car parking as well as acting as an access way for both facilities.

Hawaiian's Noranda (formerly the Noranda Square Shopping Centre) previously requested a license to use the subject land to construct car parking bays, which were required under the City's (former) Town Planning Scheme No.13 as a part of a development application to extend the floorspace of the shopping centre. The City entered a car parking license with Hawaiian's Noranda on 29 February 1988. The license allowed "the owner, its employees, agents, contractors, customers, tenants and visitors the right to pass through and enter the area for the purpose of parking motor vehicles." In return Hawaiian were required to design and construct the car parking bays on the site.

As Hawaiian were required to design, construct and maintain the car parking bays at their own cost there was no rent paid to the City as a part of the license.

The term of this agreement has now come to an end, hence this proposal to enter into a new agreement.

3.1 Carpark

The carpark is located on an elongated portion of land running along the northern boundary of Lot 100 with an area of approximately 2,740m² comprising a car park incorporating 105 line marked car bays, 2 motorcycle bays and a trolley return (shown in Figure 2).

The carpark does not have a controlled entry or exit and is available for use at all times.

3.2 Purpose of the License

The purpose of the License is to facilitate car parking and access for the Hawaiian owned Noranda (Shopping Centre) by Hawaiian employees, agents, contractors, customers, tenants and visitors and the users of the Noranda Sporting Complex.

The license agreement does not grant exclusive use of the car parking bays to Hawaiian. Other users of the area, such as Noranda Sporting Complex users are permitted to use the bays.

A recent valuation indicates that the market rental value as approximately \$16,050 pa per annum.
