## CITY OF BAYSWATER ACTIVITIES IN THOROUGHFARES AND PUBLIC PLACES AND TRADING LOCAL LAW 2020

In accordance with s3.12(6) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, the City of Bayswater gives notice that on 9 April 2021 the City of Bayswater *Activities in Thoroughfares and Public Places and Trading Local Law 2020* was published in the WA Government Gazette.

This local law was made by Council at its Ordinary Council Meeting of 23 February 2021.

The <u>purpose</u> of this local law is to make one local law regulating activities in thoroughfares and trading in thoroughfares and public places.

The <u>effect</u> of this local law is some activities in thoroughfares and public places are prohibited and some activities are permitted only under permit or in compliance with conditions set out in this local law.

In accordance with s3.14(1) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, local laws come into effect on the 14<sup>th</sup> day after the day of publication in the WA Government Gazette.

This local law will therefore be effective from 23 April 2021.
