PROPOSED STANDING ORDERS LOCAL LAW 2021

In accordance with s3.12(6) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, the City of Bayswater gives notice that on 22 September 2021 the City of Bayswater Standing Orders Local Law 2021 was published in the WA Government Gazette (Gazette Number 164 – Special Edition).

This local law was made by Council at its Ordinary Council Meeting of 24 August 2021.

The <u>purpose</u> of these standings orders is to provide for the orderly conduct of the proceedings and business of the Council.

The <u>effect</u> of these standing orders is that all Council Meetings, Committee Meetings and other meetings as described in the Act, shall be governed by these standing orders unless otherwise provided in the Act, regulations or other written law.

In accordance with s3.14(1) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, local laws come into effect on the 14th day after the day of publication in the WA Government Gazette.

This local law will therefore be effective from 6 October 2021.
