WASTE AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2022

In accordance with s3.12(6) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, the City of Bayswater gives notice that on 3 May 2022 the City of Bayswater Waste Amendment Local Law 2022 was published in the WA Government Gazette (Gazette Number 61).

This local law was made by Council at its Ordinary Council Meeting of 22 March 2022.

The <u>purpose</u> of this local law is to provide for the regulation, control and management of waste and recycling collection services within the City.

The <u>effect</u> of this local law is for the efficient separation and removal of general recycling and organics waste (FOGO) from households in the City, which will reduce the impact on landfill and better use these materials.

In accordance with s3.14(1) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, local laws come into effect on the 14th day after the day of publication in the WA Government Gazette.

This local law will therefore be effective from 17 May 2022.
