## PROPOSED KEEPING AND CONTROL OF CATS AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2024

The City of Bayswater Council resolved to amend the current *Keeping and Control of Cats Local Law 2022* at the Ordinary Council Meeting on 30 April 2024.

The purpose of the local law is to amend the City of Bayswater's *Keeping and Control of Cats Local Law 2022* to include:

- a new clause 2.3 "Cats in Other Places"
- a new offence penalty in Schedule 2, item 3; and
- "Brickworks Lake" as part of the Maylands Lakes Cat Prohibited Areas.

The effect of the amendment local law is to incorporate 'by reference' clause 3.2 'Cats in other places' of the Shire of Northam *Cat Local Law 2019* under section 82 of the *Cat Act 2011*, with minor modifications.
