9.11 Filming Permit

- (1) A permit is required for filming in a public place
- (2) Subclause 1 does not apply to filming that is for a personal or non-commercial purpose.

9.12 Duration of permit

A permit is valid for a period of three (3) months after the date on which it is issued unless it is specified otherwise in the permit.

(The expiry date of the Certificate of Currency is taken into consideration when the permit is issued).

9.13 Waived fee

The local government may waiver any fee imposed under section 6.16 of the *Local Government Act* for a filming permit if the applicant is currently enrolled as a student at any secondary or tertiary education institution.

11.5 Cancellation of permit

The City of Bayswater may cancel a permit if in his or her opinion the volume of sound caused by the permit holder in connection with the filming adversely affects the enjoyment, convenience or comfort of other persons, or if, in her or his opinion, or in the opinion of an authorised person, the filming otherwise constitutes a nuisance or if a permit holder has not complied with the conditions of the permit.

Obligations of permit holder

A permit holder shall not in a public place –

- a) perform wearing dirty, torn or ragged clothing;
- b) act in an offensive manner
- c) obstruct pedestrian or vehicular traffic
- d) place, install, erect, play or use any musical instrucment or any device which emits music, including a loud speaker or an amplifier
