KIDSPORT TOP-UP

What is City of Bayswater KidSport Top-Up funding?

On 1 January 2018, the Department of Local Government, Sport & Cultural Industries ('the Department') reduced KidSport program funding from \$200 to \$150 (per child, per calendar year). As a result, the City's Council resolved in early 2018 that a 'Top-Up' payment would be made to the City's eligible residents up to a maximum value of \$50 (including GST) per calendar year, per applicant.

Is my child eligible for Kidsport Top-Up funding?

All of the City's eligible residents with an approved KidSport application (where the club registration fees are greater than \$150), are eligible for the City's Top-Up to the maximum value of \$50 (including GST) per calendar year, per applicant.

How do I apply for City of Bayswater KidSport Top-Up Funding?

Once the KidSport application code has been received, the eligible resident is required to complete a City of Bayswater Top-Up Funding Application Form. Once complete, the form is to be returned to the club who will raise an invoice and email both forms to the City of Bayswater.

What does the City of Bayswater Top-Up Funding payment cover?

The Top-Up payment will cover registration fees only, as per KidSport conditions.

How long will the funding last?

As the Department reduced KidSport payments from \$200 to \$150 (per child, per calendar year), the City's Council approved a three year Kidsport Top-Up trial for eligible City of Bayswater residents. This funding will be reviewed annually.

What happens if the funding runs out?

The City has provided \$20,000 per financial year to fund the Kidsport Top-Up. If all funding is allocated prior to the end of the financial year, the City will not be able to process any further applications until the following financial year.
