

# CITY OF BAYSWATER PODIATRY SERVICES INFORMATION SHEET



### **Podiatry Service**

Dr Julian Boo from Life Active Podiatry operates podiatry clinics at the City's two Seniors' Centres.

The clinics are held between 8.30am and 12.30pm on a weekly basis on following days:

- Bayswater Senior Citizen Centre Wednesday
- Morley Senior Citizen Centre Thursday

### **Eligibility**

This service is offered to:

- Older adults (55 years and older); and
- Seniors, Disability or Health Care Card holders.

Please note: Only City of Bayswater residents are eligible to access to the subsidised service, and at the first appointment, will need to show proof of address.

Clients who do not reside in the City of Bayswater can access the service by arrangement with the podiatrist.

#### **Fees**

- City of Bayswater residents are charged a flat rate of \$30, as the City subsidise the podiatry service for residents.
- A competitive, low cost price of \$40.00 is charged to non-residents.
- All clients accessing the service with a valid Medicare Allied Health Service referral will be bulk-billed to ensure no out-of-pocket costs.
- Fees are non-refundable through private health insurance.

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

# 1. How will the podiatrist know who is a resident and who is a non-resident?

The podiatrist will ask clients for proof of address (driver's licence, a bill with current address, Health Care Card, disability or pension card). This information will be entered into the system, so clients re-booking appointments will not need to provide this information again. Clients will need to notify the podiatrist if they move address.

# 2. Can I access the podiatry service under the Allied Health Services Medicare scheme?

Yes, City of Bayswater residents can now access podiatry treatment under the Medicare scheme, as long as they have a valid referral. Residents should seek a referral from their GP for Life Active Podiatry. Please contact Dr Boo directly on 0423 722 957 for further information.

#### 3. How do I make payments for podiatry?

All payments for both podiatry services will be made directly to the podiatrist who will issue you with a receipt upon payment.

### 4. How do I make a booking with the Podiatrist?
